THE HARMONIC OSCILLATOR

1. Introduction

The harmonic oscillator is a fundamental system in physics.

It is a system that can be approximated by a harmonic potential.

The potential energy of a harmonic oscillator is given by

$$V(x) = \frac{1}{2}kx^2$$

where k is the spring constant and x is the displacement from equilibrium.

The force exerted by the spring is given by

$$F = -kx$$

where the minus sign indicates that the force is directed towards equilibrium.

The equation of motion for a harmonic oscillator is

$$m\ddot{x} = -kx$$

where m is the mass of the oscillator and \ddot{x} is the acceleration.

The general solution to this equation is

$$x(t) = A\cos(\omega t) + B\sin(\omega t)$$

where A and B are constants determined by the initial conditions.

The angular frequency ω is given by

$$\omega = \sqrt{\frac{k}{m}}$$

The period of oscillation T is given by

$$T = \frac{2\pi}{\omega}$$

The energy of a harmonic oscillator is constant and is given by

$$E = \frac{1}{2}kA^2$$

where A is the amplitude of oscillation.

The average energy of a harmonic oscillator is

$$\langle E \rangle = \frac{1}{2}k\langle x^2 \rangle$$
